TAX PREPARATION CHECKLIST

Use this checklist as a guide as you gather the **most common** tax documents needed to complete your tax return. **This list is not all-inclusive. You must ensure all tax documents are included based on your individual circumstances.** A tax return prepared with missing or invalid information may take longer for me to process and/or result in a tax return that needs to be amended, which comes with an additional fee.

Personal information

Photo ID of you and your spouse. (Copies are fine)

Social Security Numbers and dates of birth for you, your spouse, and all dependents claimed on the tax return.

Bank account and routing number. (Direct Deposit option)

Information about your income

2021 Summer and winter property taxes. (Not the assessment, the actual tax bill.)

All W2, 1098, 1099-C, 1099-G, 1099-MISC, 1099-R, 1099-S, 1099-INT, 1099-DIV, 1099-B, 1098, SSA-1099.

Adjustments to your income

List of charitable contributions with total for 2022.

Amount of medical expenses paid for 2022.

1098-T for tuition paid for all college aged dependents you are claiming. (You can get this from their college or University to see if you qualify for an Education Credit.)

] Daycare expenses paid for any/all children. (See Dependent Care Credit for details)

1095-A for those who had Marketplace Health Insurance.
